





Theory

Web page designing (HTML)

Html stands for Hypertext Markup language. It was developed by Tim Berners lee. Tim Berners Lee developed HTML to share the information and research work through the use of internet. HTML is markup language which is used to design webpage.

Types of tags in html:

1. Singular tag (Empty tag)

-The tag which has opening tag but no closing tag is called singular tag. For Eg:
, <hr>, etc.

2. Paired tag (Container tag)

--The tag which has both opening tag and closing tag is called paired tag. For Eg: <head>...</head>, etc.

S.N	Singular tag	S.N	Paired tag
1.	The tag which has opening tag but no closing tag is called singular tag.	1.	The tag which has both opening and closing tag is called paired tag.
2.	It is also called empty tag.	2.	It is also called container tag.
3.	For example: , <hr>, etc.	3.	For example: <head>...</head>

Formatting tag in html

1. tag : Bold the text
2. <I> tag : Italic the text
3. <U>tag : Underline the text
4. <sup>tag : Superscript the text
5. <Sub>tag : Subscript the text
6. <mark>tag : It mark or highlight the text
7. tag : It emphasize the text

Heading tags (<h1>to<h6>)

-It is used to give title or Heading in body section we can use <h1> to <h6> for heading.

<h6> MY html page</h6> - display the heading with smallest size.



Table attributes:

1. Align= table to be align in left, right or center.
2. Width= Width of table in size or percentage.
3. Border=Border of table
4. Cell padding= Space between cell border and cell content.
5. Cell spacing= Control the space between adjacent cells.
6. Colspan= Specifies how many column can be merged or combined to form single column.
7. Rowspan= Specifies how many row can be merged or combined to form single row.
8. Bg color= Background color of table.

Explain the tag with its attributes and make any simple page using these attributes.

-HTML allows placing of static and animates image in html page. Image can be inserted in webpage using tag . HTML accepts two pictures format i.e. (g.if) and (.jpeg). is singular tag i.e it doesn't have closing tag.

The attributes of tag are:

1. Align: allows us to put image in left, right or in center.
2. Width: determines width of image in pixels.
3. Height: determine the height of image in pixels.
4. Border: specifies the size of border to be placed around the table.
5. Alt: This attributes indicate text to be displayed in case if the browser is unable to display the image or if browser cannot find the image.
6. Src: Specifies the location and name of image file. Eg:-C:/sunset.jpg.

What is hyperlink?

-links are found in nearly all web pages. Links allows user to click their web page to page. A hyperlink is a text or an image we can click on and jump to another page. HTML links are called hyperlink. We can click on a link and jump to a document on same page or another/next page. When we move the mouse over the link, the mouse arrow will turn into a little hand. A link doesn't have to be text. It can be image or any other html document. Hyperlink are defined within html<a> tag. ckick here

-<input type="checkbox">defines a check button.

x. Input type file

-<input type="file">defines a file select field and "browse" button for file uploads.

3. <text area>element

-<text area> element defines a multiline input field (a text area).

4. <button>element

-The <button> element defines a clickable button.

5. <field set> and <legend> element.

-The <field set> element is used to group related data form.

-The <legend> element defines a caption for <field set> element.
